ALEJANDRA CABALLERO

Alejandra Caballero paintings are intimate, figurative, poetic and introspective. His most recurring theme is the female figure and its everyday environment. (Normally she takes herself as a model). The sea and childhood are his favorite subjects. She eliminates superfluous and anegdótic things to focus on the representation of the transcendent. She uses clear and bright colors, although his works have somehow melancholy and loneliness.

The pictures of the painter managed to defy us like once in the past Edgar Degas's or Edward Hopper's did: leading to human figures surprised in the middle of an intimate action (that's not necessarily private one) and that we estimate is absent-minded, solitary or isolated. (...) The artist offers us the pictorial story of a moment of loneliness, of concentration, of imprisonment with one itself. And to shake it resorts to the representation of prominent figures and composite elements that push us, to satisfy our curiosity, to the interpellation: ¿What sees through the window the young woman that is sitting in the bed? ¿That thoughts are in the mind of the contemplative woman in the night? (...)It is a game that makes us take sides penetrating in the fabric with a voyeur attitude.
